Take an easy 30 minute stroll around our precious remnant of lowland swamp forest, or wander through the aviaries to meet kea, kākā, kākārīki, whio and pāteke. You can view kiwi and tuatara by day, or book for the amazing Kiwi Night Encounter. Watch, or join-in, the daily feeding of the eels. There are many beautiful picnic areas to choose from, as well as a barbecue for hire.

Watch or participate in feeding endangered long-fin eels at 2pm daily.

A unique opportunity to learn about our kiwi and then observe their secret lives every Thursday to Sunday at dusk (ages 7+, bookings required).
